What was done

- More flyers distributed to area residents;
- Announcement on the TMR website, social media accounts, newsletter, etc.;
- Consultation held on May 17, 2024, at Town Hall;
- 52 participants;
- Three activities around four themes;
 - Strong/weak point identification workshop;
 - SLIDO smartphone app: fill in the blanks;
 - Brainstorming (ideas and orientations) plenary sessions;
- 146 Post-its full of ideas.

What was raised

Theme 1: Mobility

Walkability, safety, user-friendliness, reduction of space occupied by cars, accessibility to public transit

Theme 2: Built environment/quality of life/ambiance

Friendly neighbourhood ambiance; Dynamism, Mix of types of lodging; Underground parking

Theme 3: Mix of uses

Vertical mix; Neighbourhood businesses; Socialization and culture

Theme 4: Environment

Revegetation; Human scale; Green and shaded spaces

Summary

Mobility is a major concern, especially for pedestrians and accessing public transit;

A friendly neighbourhood atmosphere and a mix of lodging types are desired;

Mixed usage is valued;

An environment with added vegetation;

Reduction in the presence of cars.
