## COMPLETE | PARTIAL CLOSURES

- Eastbound Côte-de-Liesse Road | Northbound Canora Road -

Please be advised of two upcoming road closures affecting access to buildings at 5, 25, 45, 65, and 85 Brittany Avenue:

- Partial closure of northbound Canora Road, between Brittany Avenue and Côte-de-Liesse Road.
- Full and partial closure of eastbound Côte-de-Liesse Road, between Canora Road and Fleming Park.

These obstructions are due to work being conducted by the Commission des services électriques de Montréal (CSEM) on their access shafts. The work is scheduled to take place from March 17 to April 29, 2025, between 7 a.m. and 8 p.m.



<sup>1</sup> A temporary underpass will be set up beneath the A40, east of Canora Road, allowing left turns from westbound Côte-de-Liesse Road onto eastbound Côte-de-Liesse Road. <sup>2</sup> Northbound traffic on Canora Road will be detoured via Brittany Avenue and Rockland Road to reach eastbound Côte-de-Liesse Road. <sup>3</sup> Access to southbound Canora Road from westbound Côte-de-Liesse Road will remain available, except between 7:00 and 9:00 a.m. Signage will be provided to guide traffic.
